37 Fat Quarters - A short film about the Downton Abbey inspired fabrics

Susan is an avid button collector, a member of the Colorado State Button Society and the Vedauwo Charmstring Button Club which meets here in Cheyenne. Currently she is the editor of the Button Basket for Colorado, a twice-a-year publication, and she is writing a handbook on ceramic buttons. Susan has been sewing since Jr. High and made her first quilt in her early twenties. About eight or nine years ago she took Beginning Quilting with Barb Boyer at Around the Block quilt store in Cheyenne and has been quilting since.

#### **Film Bio:**

A year or so prior to taking her first quilt class she attended a one-day film class with her friend. Luana wanted to enter a film contest and Susan went along to help. We studied and learned quite a bit and ended up taking first place for a seven-minute film Luana wrote, directed and produced. Susan assisted on several more of Luana's projects, but only had one small film of her own. It was a fun little film on the first ever Zombiefest held in Cheyenne. Susan's one big film project so far, is the one you will see on Tuesday, September 5th, 2023, called "37 Fat Quarters."

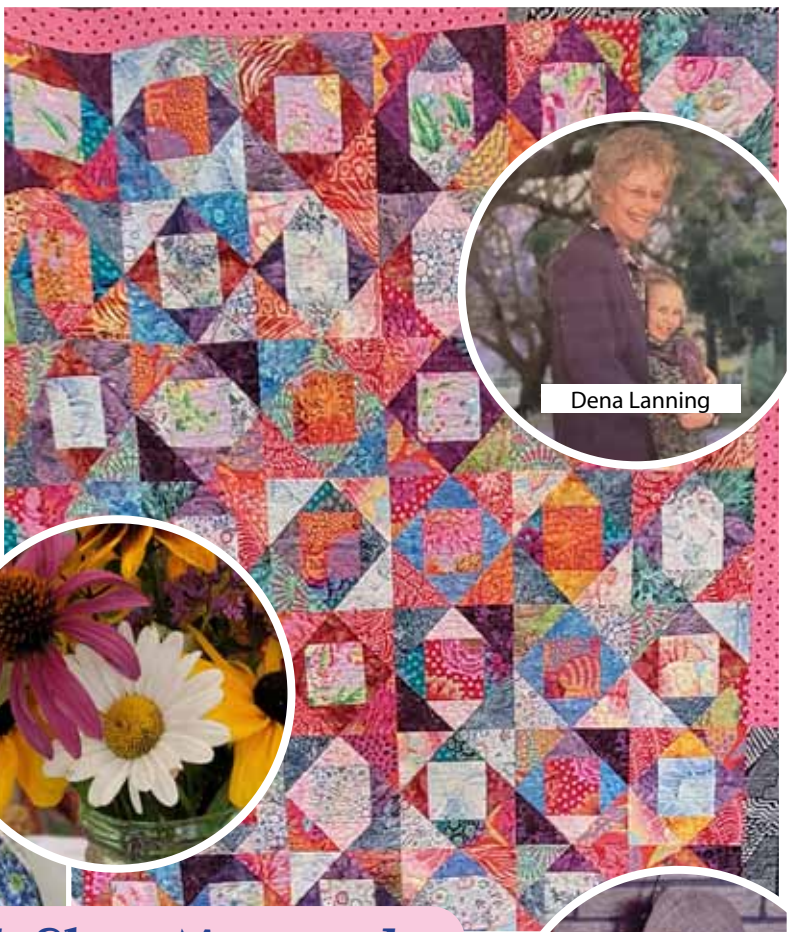
