# Cheyenne Heritage Quilters 2015 Challenge

### Git 'R' Done

This is a challenge to not only participate in but to actually finish.

- 1) Find a UFO that can be adapted for this challenge. That is not to say you can't start a brand new project for this challenge. Even an idea that you have had for a quilt could be considered a UFO in the very broadest sense.
- 2) A majority of the fabric in the packet must be included on the front of your finished product with the stipulation that at least one of the Steamboats must be appear in its entirety on the front of the quilt.
- 3) The quilt can be any shape, but the combined total of all sides of the quilt cannot be less than 72 inches nor more than 324 inches (for example an 18" x 18" quilt equals 72", a 72" x 90" quilt equals 324"). A round quilt cannot have a diameter greater than 72 inches.
- 4) This must be a quilted project consisting of three layers; top, batting and back. You may use any techniques/embellishments you wish. The edges must be finished and it must be quilted by hand or machine.
- 5) Make sure your quilt has a label on the back to identify the owner and maker.
- 6) Completed entry forms need to be turned in by August 1, 2015. Quilts need to be dropped off at FRONTIER UMC (1888 E Four Mile Rd., northwest corner of Powderhouse and Four Mile) on August 3 or 10 between 5pm & 8pm.

Buckaroo-You are a novice quilter, this is your first time in a show.

**GOWDOY**-This is not your first rodeo, but not a professional.

**Professional Bullrider** - You've entered shows and won prizes.

A first, second and third place will be awarded for each category and one judge's choice. Judging emphasizes originality, creative use of theme and challenge fabric as it relates to other fabrics, visual impact, and workmanship. Judges have the right to determine the final category and all judges' decision are final.


