Sewing activity for CHQ member: Carole Gardner:

ROW EXCHANGE This is how it works: We will be making rows for each other instead of doing a border around a quilt.

- 1. You choose a theme for your quilt. any theme and technique or a combination.
- 2. You make your first row the length you want. We do not want them large, so try to stay within about 30-45 inches, or smaller. Everybody else will be expected to make the rows the same length as yours. The width of the row will be determined by the person making it.
- 3. Write your theme, special instructions and suggestions on a sheet of paper and put it in your bag. It needs to remain with the bag. You may want to staple or tape it to the bag. You are welcome to put fabric and/or patterns in the bag. But you do not have
- 4. Be prepared to follow the theme and special instructions for each exchange that comes to you. Do not sew the rows together.
- 5. A quilt label will be provided in each bag. Make sure you sign it before passing to the next person.
- 6. Sign up will be in February. Call Carole Gardner 631-7388 to sign up. Group assignments and bags will be passed out on March 5th. First exchange will be April 2nd. Exchanges will be the first meeting of each month. Pass to the person whose name is below yours on the group list.
- 7. BE DILIGENT ABOUT GETTING THE BAG PASSED EACH EXCHANGE. If you cannot be there, get someone to pass for you.

Community Quilts sew at the Library. See Deb Pryzmus.




