Size - Wall Hanging 24x24 to Lap 44 x "54

You have 3 paint chips to work with. The design you use is your choice. You can use any and all shades on the paint chip for your project. Prints and florals can be used as long as the Paint Chip colors are in the additional fabric.

A pocket needs to be added to the back to hold the 3 paint chips. Please add a hanging sleeve.


