November 6th Program - Marci Baker The Serendipity of Fabulous Fabrics Stacked Repeats

Marci Baker is internationally recognized for her expertise in quilting. She enjoys sharing ideas that simplify the quilting process.

A native of Dallas, Texas she began teaching quilting in 1989 for her local quilting guild and shops. In 1993 she started Alicia's Attic, a company that combines her love of math, teaching, and her love of quilting. As an admirer of traditional quilts, Marci was inspired to author the "Not Your Grandmother's Quilts" book series, which uses traditional patterns that people associate with grandmothers but simplifies the techniques.

In 2006 she expanded Alicia's Attic by purchasing Clearview Triangle from Sara Nephew. Marci and Sara are collaborating on new designs and techniques, with Marci traveling and teaching under her new business name: "Quilt with Marci Baker".

One of her latest adventures is teaching on Creative Spark, the online learning platform by C & T Publishing. Marci currently lives in Ft. Collins, CO with her husband Clint where they enjoy the beauty of the mountains. She has traveled and taught quilting classes as far north as Edmonton, Canada, as far south as Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, as far east as Muscat, Oman, and far west as Soldotna, Alaska.


