#### CHQ BOARD APPROVES WEBPAGE NEWSLETTER

The CHQ board voted at the October Board meeting to create a website that would be easy to update. Start-up costs will be \$325.00, annual fee will be \$25.00, and monthly fee will be \$30.00. We plan to recoup the expense with savings on newsletter print and postage by encouraging members to go online to read the CHQ newsletter or print their own copy in color. Members will continue to get the paper copy of the newsletter until they ask to switch. Last year, 73 of our



members listed an email address. If 50 of them chose to switch, the website will pay for itself. The website will also act as publicity for the guild. It will be very useful for advertising our meetings and the quilt show, cutting down on phone inquiries and SASEs. Initially, the one-page website will contain information about CHQ, our meeting schedule, our other activities, and a link to the current newsletter. 

#### CHQ quilt show 2011 Initial Plans Set \_

2011 Quilt Show Chair: Barb Gorges, (bgorges4@msn.com)

Seven CHQ members with a total of over 100 years' experience with our annual quilt show have planned the remodel for 2011. The dates will be Aug. 25-27 (last month I was not quite correct), though Thursday will be open late afternoon into the evening instead of the usual 10 a.m. -4 p.m.

Based on survey results, we will have the Silent Auction again, but there will be limits. We will ask that large quilts for sale be hung as regular quilt entries so they can be displayed rather than folded up. We will have quilt appraisals, quilt critiques, demonstrations and a few, selected vendors. New will be an area advertising CHQ and its activities. A \$2 per person admission fee will go to First United Methodist Church in lieu of rent, but any CHQ members working will get in free.

We will schedule children's activities at another time, save door prize solicitation for events with mostly quilters in attendance (what do non-quilters do with the fat quarters they win?) and not have a featured quilter this year as we get acclimated to the new venue.

Volunteers so far include chairs Bea Dersham (appraisals), Florence Brown (hostessing), Jeannie Wilson (memorials, if necessary), Penny Morris (quilt critiques and vendors), Carole Gardner (raffle quilt), Cindy Paul and Kathy Sconce (raffle ticket sales), and Mona Weeks (quilt stand building).

In January we will have a meeting to organize publicity and a timeline for other tasks such as selling program advertising, advertising for quilt entries, and designing the silent auction and show layout. 
Update Editor Judy Gilmore

#### Meeting Schedule


