**Feb. 4, 2013** - Bring the project to trade and receive a project from someone else.

**April 1, 2013** - Bring the project to trade and receive a project from someone else.

**May 5, 2013** - Round Robin Luncheon – return the projects to their owners.

By Act of Congress, no less -- Smiley was created by Harvey Ball in 1963 and quickly became a global icon. October offers many reasons to smile...Autumn Leaves, Halloween, Football. Lets all celebrate this Smiley Day in your favorite background fabric. Officially, Smiley is yellow, but forget the color police. Smiley loves the rainbow – and all Holidaze!



SMILE: this is Fall - Off -Your - Sewing - Chair ....Simple

### **Ingredients**

12.5" square background fabric

7-9" salad plate –Smiley Pattern

Yellow (or your favorite color for your Smiley

Black Fabric scraps

### **Assembly**

Trace the plate onto the yellow fabric. ( Or your special fabric) Applique your favorite Smiley smile onto the circle, using your favorite method. Then applique Smiley onto the background fabric. Centered or off - the choice is yours.

Remember to smile every day. See someone without a smile –Give her one of yours
