2012 Cluster Meetings Daenette More

We are concentrating on community service with an emphasis on community as (getting together, having fun and working on community projects. Plus those of you who would like to infuse your quilting with painting, we have got the cluster for you!.

- (1) BINDING BEE which is our own twist on quilting bee. As most of our community quilts are machine quilted, we are hosting a community binding party! Each quilt will be spread out on a table with the binding sewed on ready to have the handwork done on complete the quilt We will have a group of women with needles in hand in a quilting bee style to finish some of our quilts! Sounds like fun.
- (2) Learn the technique of a 6 hour quilt by Kaye Woods who takes strips of fabric and batting and sew as you go technique to complete a double sided wonderful quilt for Project Linus or Community quilts. Learn what it takes from the very beginning to the finished project. Can be done in cluster or at home after the first demonstration.
- (3) Hot Dog Pillowcases There are several pillowcase projects going on nationally and even in local Wyoming. Come and get the instructions, learn to make a pillowcase with 2 seams and learn about several donation projects that would just love to have your support and pillowcases.
- (4) Painting on Fabric learn from our own Carol Gardner and buy your own set of paints to embellish your quilts or paint on a sample that can become your next medallion quilt! ! This is a different technique than taught last year so come and expand your horizons.
