I hope everyone is ready to get started! I hope your fabric is cut out and ready to go! Our first 2 blocks for July are the Four-Patch Block, you will be making two blocks, each block has a separate colorway.

You will be using:

Fabric A, Shape 1 Qty 2

Fabric H, Shape 1 Qty 2

Fabric K, Shape 1 Qty 2

If you have any of the CHQ AccuQuilt dies and are done using them, please return them to Donna Dolan at the next guild meeting. Thank you.

If you are an organizer like me, there is a mistake in one of the photos on which fabric to use: For the Propeller block, first colorway, The 4 patch should be labeled Fabric G, NOT J. Also, I am working on compiling the list of what shape and fabric each block needs, if you would like that now versus each month, please send me an email asking for it.

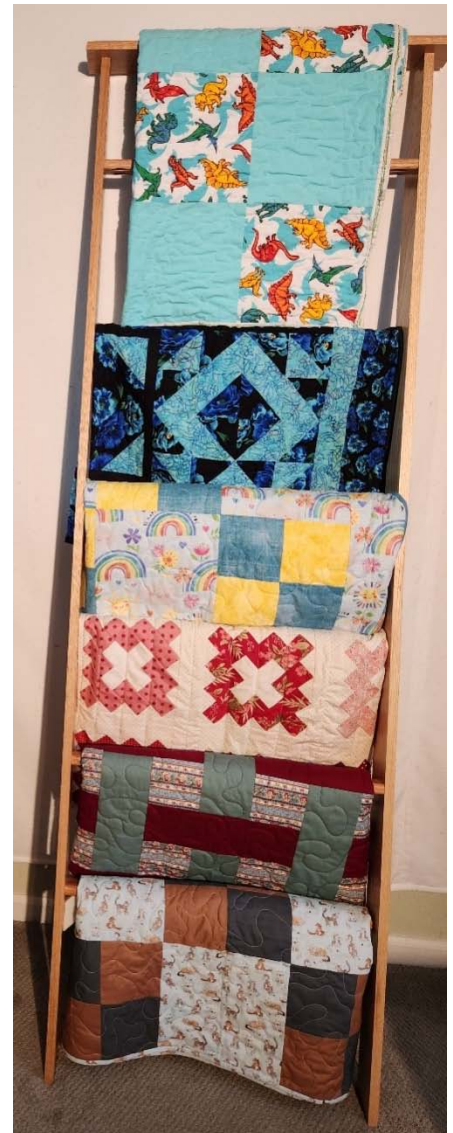

- Twin: 63" by 87"

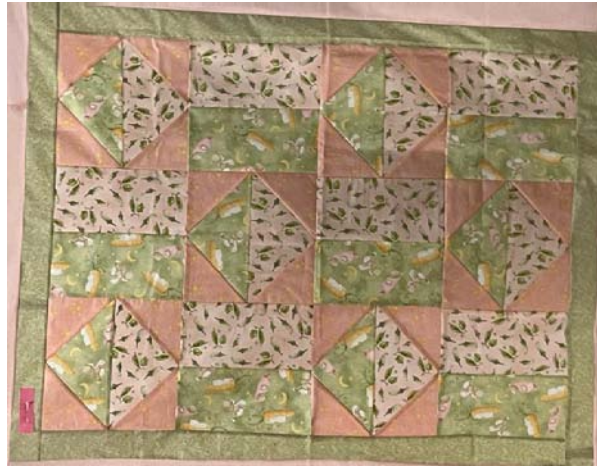

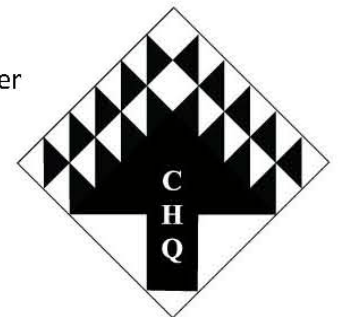
